Foundation meets every week at 7pm at the Taylor's home with the vision to empower and equip those who attend to share the Good News of Jesus to their own friends around them in every day life.

Throughout the season of Lent we are going to study a mini-series thinking about *Living Generously*. We are going to be using some materials produced by an organisation called *Stewardship* to support our bible studies and response times.



Mentoring is about building up a friendship that helps encourages and supports the young person with their faith and other matters in their life.

Over the next few months Fiona will offer to meet each young person who attends Upper Room Sunday for a coffee (or hot chocolate!) to see if mentoring is for them.



Upper Room Sunday meets during our main church service on Sunday mornings. 10:30am-12pm. We use our time together to discuss, explore and creatively reflect on God, what the Bible has to say to us today and if it's still relevant today what challenges it holds for us.

This term we are getting back to basics and looking at the foundations of the Christian faith:

- Living as a Christian: reading the bible
- Living as a Christian: Praying
- Living as a Christian: In a church family
- Living as a Christian: help from the Holy Spirit

We encourage all young people who normally attend this group to make each week as they follow on from each other.
